

ORDINANCE NO. 2019 - 2

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE BONDING REQUIREMENTS
FOR VARIOUS VILLAGE OFFICIALS**

WHEREAS, Section 121.01 of the Code of Ordinances establishes the bonding requirement for the Mayor, which is set in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000); and

WHEREAS, Section 123.11 of the Code of Ordinances sets the bonding requirement for the Clerk Treasurer position at Thirty Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000), which position has now been eliminated with the update of the Village Charter and the establishment of the office of the Village Fiscal Officer; and

WHEREAS, Council does desire to update the requirements for bonding for all Village officials and to set such bonding requirement consistent with the Village's available coverage and the needs of the public offices at Thirty Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000) per official.

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Golf Manor, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

SECTION I. The bonding requirement established by the Code of Ordinances and required by Ohio law for the Mayor and Village Administrator shall each be established at Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000). The bonding requirement for the Village Fiscal Officer and Police Clerk shall each be established at Thirty Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000). The Village Administrator, working with the Village surety and insurance carrier, shall set such additional bonds as may be needed for public employees trusted with cash transactions. Such surety bond shall be posted at the time any person is appointed to or elected to such position and shall continue during their term of office.

SECTION II. As appropriate, from time to time, when a separate person is appointed and designated as the Assistant Village Fiscal Officer or the Assistant Administrator, a similar bond shall be required for such Assistant's position.

SECTION III. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, specifically Code Sections 121.01 and 123.11.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall take effect the earliest opportunity as allowable by law.
