

RESOLUTION NO. 2021 - 5

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATION TO APPLY FOR AND ADMINISTER FUNDING FROM THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021

WHEREAS, Congress has enacted the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 from which through federal, state and local management the Village of Golf Manor has been allocated funds to assist the Village to recover economically from the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Administration has requested, and Village Council does agree, to authorize the Village Administrator and/or Village Fiscal Officer to execute any and all documentation necessary to participate in the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 and to expend such funds received for eligible expenses.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Golf Manor, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

SECTION I. Council does hereby authorize the Village Administrator and the Village Fiscal Officer to execute any and all documentation required, including an application, and if appropriate, a Participation Agreement, to allow the Village of Golf Manor to participate in funding allocated from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 to the Village of Golf Manor. All monies for which the Administration may apply and for which funds may be appropriated and expended shall be only those eligible expenses which may be identified in the rules and regulations associated with this program to the extent that such eligible expenses will assist the Village in recovering from the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic.

SECTION II. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.


