RESOLUTION NO. 2021 - 21

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATION TO APPLY FOR AND PARTICIPATE IN FUNDING TO SUPPORT REPAIRS TO ELBROOK AVENUE

WHEREAS, in cooperation with the Village Engineer, the Village Administration has pursued funding to support the repair and rehabilitation of Elbrook Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Village has been invited to make application to participate in a grant/loan program administered through the State of Ohio and Hamilton County to provide funding up to \$750,000 for such project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Golf Manor, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

SECTION I.

To enable the Village to participate in loans and/or grant programs available through the State of Ohio and the County of Hamilton for rehabilitation and repair Elbrook Avenue, the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to make application for and to secure a project Agreement for the reconstruction and repair of Elbrook Avenue. Once the loan/grant has been awarded to the Village and funding sources more properly identified, Council will look to enact additional legislation authorizing a project Agreement and authorizing construction of such project consistent with the State and County programs.

SECTION II.

In addition to any application, the Village Administration is authorized to execute such additional documentation as may be required to request participation in this program and the award of such funds.

SECTION III. This Resolution shall take effect the earliest opportunity as allowable by law.
