## ORDINANCE NO. 2022 - 7

## AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING AN INDIVIDUAL FOR FAILURE TO CARRY THEIR DRIVERS LICENSE ON THEIR PERSON WHILE OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE

WHEREAS, to ensure that any driver who is stopped by Golf Manor Police Department while operating a motor vehicle on the streets of Golf Manor can be properly identified, the Police Department has recommended, and the Administration concurs, that a specific Ordinance requiring all drivers within the Village carry and present a State licensed identification when stopped is the best tool to enforce this goal.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Golf Manor, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

The operator of a motor vehicle shall carry on his or her person his or her Ohio motor vehicle operator's license, out-of-state motor vehicle license, or temporary permit when he or she is operating a motor vehicle within the Village of Golf Manor.

**SECTION II.** Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor punishable by a fine of up to \$150.00.

**SECTION III.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION IV.** This Ordinance shall take effect the earliest opportunity as allowable by law.
