

ORDINANCE NO. 2022 - 7

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING AN INDIVIDUAL FOR FAILURE
TO CARRY THEIR DRIVERS LICENSE ON THEIR PERSON
WHILE OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE**

WHEREAS, to ensure that any driver who is stopped by Golf Manor Police Department while operating a motor vehicle on the streets of Golf Manor can be properly identified, the Police Department has recommended, and the Administration concurs, that a specific Ordinance requiring all drivers within the Village carry and present a State licensed identification when stopped is the best tool to enforce this goal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Golf Manor, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:


SECTION I. The operator of a motor vehicle shall carry on his or her person his or her Ohio motor vehicle operator's license, out-of-state motor vehicle license, or temporary permit when he or she is operating a motor vehicle within the Village of Golf Manor.

SECTION II. Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor punishable by a fine of up to \$150.00.

SECTION III. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall take effect the earliest opportunity as allowable by law.
