Attached are three pieces of legislation for our scheduled Council meeting Tuesday, September 29, 2020 at 7:00 PM.

1. Resolution No. 2020-13

A Resolution Accepting the Amounts and Rates as Determined by the Hamilton County Budget Commission and Authorizing the Necessary Tax Levies and Certifying Them to the County Auditor

Each year after our Budget is submitted to the Hamilton County Budget Commission and approved, the Auditor sends to the Village a schedule of the current levies approved by the Village to generate monies either to the General Fund through operating levies or specific Funds such as the Police Department Fund which will be taxed against the Village residents. These levies previously have been approved by the voters, but each year we are required to reaffirm the levies to enable the Treasurer/Auditor to assess the tax against properties within the Village. This is not a tax increase, but only reaffirmation of those existing levies approved by residence.

2. Resolution No. 2020 - 14

A Resolution Declaring the Official Intent and Reasonable Expectation of the Village of Golf Manor on behalf of the State of Ohio (the Borrower) to Reimburse its Capital Improvement Fund for the Vera, Elbrook, and Vera Service Drive Improvements, CB29X with the Proceeds of Tax Exempt Debt of the State of Ohio.

This Resolution authorizes the Village Administrator to enter into an Agreement with the Ohio Public Works Commission through the State Capital Improvements Program for a grant/loan for construction of the Vera Avenue project. The Village has been awarded a grant/loan to fund construction of this project up to the amount of \$847,880.00 for calendar year 2021. Half of this total amount is in the form of a grant. The remaining 50% of the award is in the form of a loan to be repaid over an extended period of time.

3. Resolution No. 2020 - 15

A Resolution Amending Resolution No. 2020-11 Authorizing a Lease/Purchase of a Police Vehicle

This Resolution amends Resolution No. 2020-11 which authorized the purchase of a police vehicle through John Jones Auto Group. Apparently, the loan terms as outlined with U.S. Bancorp were incorrectly stated in the Resolution and U.S. Bancorp has asked us to update the Resolution to state the specific semi-annual payment amount, which is \$10,964.13. The Resolution previously listed the authorized amount at \$10,442.53. The Department already has accepted delivery of the vehicle pending payment from U.S. Bancorp, which will be released as soon as the Resolution is properly updated.

4. Ordinance No. 2020-10

An Ordinance to Amend Appropriations for Current Expenses and Other Expenditures of the Village of Golf Manor for the Fiscal Year Ending December 31, 2020 to Appropriate Funds to be Received for Coronavirus Relief

Recently the Village was awarded additional COVID-19 relief funds in addition to the funds appropriated by Ordinance No. 2020-9. This Ordinance amends our prior Ordinances to acknowledge these additional appropriations consistent with the terms of the grant. Attached to the Ordinance will be the reallocation as prepared by our Village Fiscal Officer, Andy Lanser. Council will need to pass this Ordinance and suspend the second and third readings so that the reappropriation takes effect immediately.

RESOLUTION NO. 2020 - 13

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES AS DETERMINED BY THE HAMILTON COUNTY BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR

WHEREAS, this Council, in accordance with the provisions of law, has previously adopted a Tax Budget for the next succeeding fiscal year commencing January 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission of Hamilton County, Ohio, has certified its action thereon to the Golf Manor City Council, together with an estimate by the County Auditor of the rate of each tax necessary to be levied by this Council and what part thereof is without, and what part is within the ten-mill tax limitation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Golf Manor, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

SECTION I. The rates, as determined by the Budget Commission in its certification, as set forth on the attached Schedule A, are hereby accepted.

SECTION II. There is hereby levied on the Village of Golf Manor's tax duplicate the rate of each tax necessary to be levied without and within the ten-mill limitation, as detailed on attached Schedule A, which Schedule A is adopted by reference as if fully restated herein.

SECTION III. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

RESOLUTION NO. 2020 - 15

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2020-11 AUTHORIZING A LEASE/PURCHASE OF A POLICE VEHICLE

WHEREAS, Council did adopt Resolution No. 2020-11 entitled A Resolution Authorizing a Lease/Purchase of a Police Vehicle Through John Jones Auto Group, MobilComm and U.S. Bancorp Government Leasing and Financing, Inc. to allow the Police Department to acquire a 2019 Dodge Ram Pickup Truck; and

WHEREAS, the specific terms for the lease/purchase have been updated, and U.S. Bancorp has requested that Resolution No. 2020-11 be amended to correctly state the term and amount for the lease/purchase; and

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of the Administration, Council does hereby agree to update Resolution No. 2020-11.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Golf Manor, Hamilton County, Ohio, that:

SECTION I. Section V of Resolution No. 2020-11 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION V. The Village Administrator is authorized to enter into an additional contract with U.S. Bancorp Government Leasing and Financing, Inc. for the lease of such motor vehicle through their government lease purchase program in the approximate amount of \$63,000.00 for a period not to exceed Three budget years. The terms of such lease/purchase shall provide for semi-annual installment payments of \$10,964.13 commencing March 1, 2021 consistent with the proposal previously provided by U.S. Bancorp Government Leasing and Financing, Inc. to the Village.

SECTION II. All other portions of Resolution No. 2020-11 are hereby ratified and reaffirmed.

SECTION III. This Resolution shall take effect the earliest opportunity as allowable by law.
