Mayflower is funded, but Chuck Harmon and Rosedale are not.</p> <p>Ms. Kreimer asked about what road projects are in the pipeline.</p> <p>Mr. Michelson requested an outline of current levies on the books for the Village.</p> <p>Feb 2 will require a special meeting of council to request the levy be on the ballot, since Auditor certification will not take place until after the resolution of necessity is received.</p>

Issued Jan 19. Responses are due by March 5. A recommendation to Finance and Council will be on March 17.</p> <p>Motino to recommend Council approval of both finance packets by Mr. Fischer.  Second by Mr. Michelson.  All voted in favor.</p>
