### RECYCLE THESE

Material should be clean, empty and placed into recycling containers loose.

#### PAPER



Cardboard should fit inside cart.

#### CARTONS



No egg or ice cream cartons.  
Remove caps and straws.

#### METAL CANS



Non-hazardous, non-flammable material only.

#### PLASTIC BOTTLES, JUGS & TUBS



Reattach lid. Yogurt and fruit cups OK.

#### GLASS BOTTLES & JARS



Any color. Reattach lid.

### TRASH COLLECTION

- Trash is collected on Tuesdays.
- All trash must be placed at the curb for collection in a Rumpke issued trash container. Trash placed at the curb in bags or non-Rumpke issued containers will not be collected.
- Residents can choose from 65-gallon or 95-gallon carts. If your current Rumpke-issued cart is too large/too small, please contact Rumpke at 1-800-828-871 to request the appropriate size.

### ADDITIONAL TRASH CARTS

- Golf Manor allows single-family and two-family properties to order up to two (2) Rumpke issued trash carts at no additional cost. Multi-unit properties with four units may order up to four (4) Rumpke issued trash carts.
- If households need more carts than what is included in the contracted rate, they may request them from Rumpke at the rate of \$3.50 per cart, per month.

### LARGE ITEM PICKUP

- Households can place one large item at the curb each week. A large item is considered any item too big to fit inside a Rumpke trash cart like furniture, appliances or mattresses.
- All mattresses, box springs and upholstered furniture must be wrapped and sealed in plastic.
- Freon must be removed by a certified professional and documentation affixed to appliance prior to collection.
- Contact Rumpke prior to placing at curb to ensure items are properly prepared for collection.

### YARD WASTE

- Rumpke will provide a separate, seasonal yard waste collection on Mondays, mid-October thru mid-December each year. This year's collection will occur October 18-December 6. Rumpke will also collect yard waste on Mondays, during the month of April.
- Residents can place yard waste at the curb for collection with trash, when separate yard waste collection isn't offered.
- Brush and branches must be bundled in sections no longer than 4 feet and no wider than 2 feet. Leaves and grass clippings must be bagged in yard waste bags. Bags should not exceed 50 lbs. No dirt or rocks accepted.

### RECYCLING COLLECTION

- Beginning October 5, recycling will be collected weekly on Tuesdays.
- All recycling must be placed at the curb for collection in a Rumpke issued recycling container. Recycling placed outside of the cart won't be collected.
- All recycling should be placed into carts loose. Don't place material inside of plastic bags. Plastic bags aren't accepted in Rumpke's recycling program and hinder the recycling process.
- See reverse side for what can be recycled.

### REMINDERS

- Material should be placed curbside the night before scheduled service day.
- Rumpke observes Christmas Day and New Year's Day. If your service day falls on the actual holiday or after that actual holiday, collection will be delayed one day that week.

### PROHIBITED ITEMS & SPECIAL MATERIALS

- According to federal law, Rumpke is not permitted to accept batteries, tires, liquids, combustible materials, items that contain CFC or any item identified as hazardous or flammable.
- Construction materials including drywall, concrete, bricks, dirt and rocks should not be placed in residential trash or recycling. Contact Rumpke for a construction container for removal.
- Medical sharps and needles should be placed in a hard plastic container with a lid secured with duct tape. The container should be clearly labeled "SHARPS" with permanent marker and placed in trash container.
- Latex paint is accepted; however, it must be completely dry or solidified prior to disposal. Lids should be left off of paint cans so driver can confirm paint meets criteria.
