Golf Manor to Install New Mayor and 3 Council Members Monday, Dec. 9, 2019

GOLF MANOR, OH – (12/8/2019) – A new mayor and three new council members will be sworn in at the Village of Golf Manor's regular council meeting on Monday, December 9, 2019 at 7 PM. Proceedings will take place in the Village Community Hall located at 6450 Wiehe Road.

Stefan Densmore, appointed Village mayor in September, won the seat in the November election and will be sworn in by Commissioner Denise Driehaus to a four-year term on Monday night.

Daniel Kneipp and Roger Van Harn, both of whom had been previously appointed to open council seats, won four-year terms in November and will be sworn in by Judge Thomas O. Beridon of the Court of Common Pleas.

Eric Pridonoff, a newcomer to Village council, was elected for a two-year term to complete the term of an open seat and will be sworn in by Rabbi Elliot Polsky.

A reception will follow in the Community Hall after the regular council meeting. Residents, neighbors, and guests are welcome to attend.
