WHEREAS, as a volunteer with the Women's Club and Recreation Commission, she contributed to the success of many events (e.g., dances, pool parties, soap box derby, festivals, and Fourth of July Celebrations) enjoyed by generations of Golf Manor residents, and for other contributions too numerous to mention,

NOW THEREFORE, I, Mayor Alan Zaffiro, declare Sunday, June 14, 2015 as "Donna Faulk Day" in the Village of Golf Manor, Ohio.

I ask the community on that day to join us in thanking Donna for her dedication to the Village of Golf Manor and wishing her a long, happy retirement.

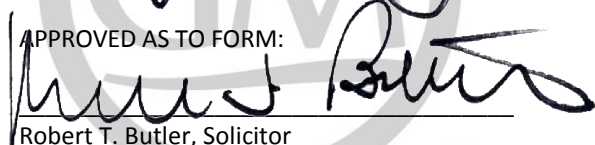
