



HONORING National Peace Officers' Memorial Day

WHEREAS, National Peace Officers' Memorial Day honors the service and sacrifice of those peace officers killed in the line of duty while protecting our local communities.

WHEREAS, the Village of Golf Manor stands in solidarity with its neighboring communities, mourning the loss of peace officers who have made the ultimate sacrifice, being killed protecting others; and

WHEREAS, more than 20,000 law enforcement officers in the United States have made this ultimate sacrifice; and

WHEREAS, the 5 most recent local officers who have died in the line of duty are:

Corporal Adam S. McMillan Hamilton County Sheriff's Office End of Watch October 23, 2020

Detective Jorge Rene DelRio Dayton Police Department End of Watch November 7, 2019

Detective Dale James Woods Colerain Township Police Department End of Watch January 7th 2019; and Police Officer Kaia Grant Springdale Police Department End of Watch March 21, 2020

Detective William Lee Brewer Jr. Clermont County Sheriff's Department End of Watch February 2, 2019

WHEREAS, President Kennedy and The United States Congress designated that May 15th be Peace Officers Memorial Day, and that the U.S. flag be flown at half-staff on this date each year;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Stefan Densmore, Mayor of the Village of Golf Manor, do hereby publicly recognize and respect the daily toll on families and intimate friends of active-duty peace officers, and salute the courageous and selfless service of peace officers in our community and in communities across the nation.
