Subject: Monthly Departmental Update and Community Initiatives

1. Crime Statistics & Patrol Update

I am pleased to report that crime remains low within the Village. Currently, our highest call volumes are attributed to quality-of-life issues, followed closely by Squad EMS runs.

- **High Visibility:** In response to the warmer weather and the historically higher potential for criminal activity during this season, officers are maintaining an increased presence throughout the Village.
- **Vigilance:** Residents are reminded to remain vigilant and report any suspicious activity to law enforcement immediately.
- **Juvenile Curfew:** Parents are reminded to adhere to the Village Juvenile Curfew Ordinance (531.01-04).

Topic	Regulation / Ordinance
Property Upkeep	Yard maintenance must be kept up; inoperative or dismantled vehicles are prohibited.
Unregistered Vehicles	Vehicles without valid registration are not permitted on any roadway.
Prohibited Parking	Parking that blocks driveways, or is located on yards/sidewalks, is unlawful (351.03).
72-Hour Rule	No vehicle may be parked consecutively for more than 72 hours without moving (351.05).
Noise Control	Objectionable noise is prohibited between 10:00 PM and 7:00 AM . Any noise audible from 100 feet is unlawful.
Animal Control	Dogs that disturb the peace via continuous barking or howling are deemed unlawful.

3. New Community Initiatives

We are entering an exciting phase of community engagement with several new programs on the horizon:

- **Public Safety Advisory Committee:** I have begun the process of forming this committee and am seeking **resident volunteers**. If you are interested in the scope and goals of this group, please contact my office directly.
- **Citizens Police Academy:** Our inaugural academy is scheduled for **Fall 2026**. This program will provide residents with an inside look at departmental operations.
- **Neighborhood Watch / Citizens on Patrol:** We are in the early planning stages of a formalized "Citizens on Patrol" program. Stay tuned for further updates.
