

Mayors Report September 2026

Village Administrator Search Update. As I've mentioned in my past two mayor's reports, I've been working with Michael T. Hinnenkamp, Executive Director of the Ohio Plan, to put together an executive search process to hire a new full time administrator. Our interim village administrator, Nathan Cahall, has been helping me with this— answering questions that prospective administrators would need to know about the job, and identifying the components of the job that we should highlight in our application materials to attract more prospects. Mr. Hinnenkamp has shared with me several of the challenges we face in the current local job market, and will review those with the council as well. He'll be asking for input from council tonight into what kind of characteristics, skills and experience we're looking for. Nathan and I have already chimed in about this. He will also be answering any questions the council has about the process he will be using to find candidates and vet them for us, and how long it can reasonably be expected to take from here to finish.

Mr Hinnenkamp is attending the meeting this evening. I'll do an introduction and have him say a few words. And then we'll move into executive session, which he has requested to discuss the details of the appointment, employment, and compensation, as allowed under section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code. I've requested that we do this during the Mayor's report, at the beginning of the meeting, in respect to the time Mr. Hennenkamp has available for us.

Bio for Michael Hinnenkamp

Michael Hinnenkamp is the Executive Director for Ohio Plan Risk Management, Inc. The Ohio Plan is comprised of over 900 Ohio public entity Members and provides risk management coverage, executive recruitment, customized management, strategic planning, training, human resources, and cyber security services to its Members.

Overall, he has nearly 40 years of executive public leadership experience which includes service for three diverse jurisdictions in progressive executive leadership positions. Prior to joining the Ohio Plan, as Executive Director in 2018, he spent 22 years as Township Administrator for Springfield Township, Hamilton County.

Mr. Hinnenkamp is certified by the International City/County Manager's Association (ICMA) as a Credentialed Manager. He has a master's degree in public administration and a bachelor's degree in urban planning from the University of Cincinnati. He also has a State of Ohio Department of Insurance Casualty and Property Insurance License.

He currently serves as an Adjunct Professor for the University Cincinnati Master of Public Administration Program in the School for Public and International Affairs.

He has served in a leadership capacity on a wide variety of Boards including: Past President of the Center for Local Government and Cincinnati Area Managers Association; Past Treasurer of the First Suburbs Consortium of Southwest Ohio; Board of Trustee Member of the Hamilton County Development Corporation; and the Ohio Plan.

Tots to Teens Event. There is a resource event supporting prenatal Health and Child Development that will occur in Volunteer Park this Saturday, from 10 AM to 2 PM. I've been asking the county to increase funding to support weekend operations of the 513 Relief bus for a couple years now. The 513 Relief bus is a mobile resource center that helps struggling individuals and families connect to resources. Many of these struggling individuals and families, however, are at work during the current operational hours of the bus— so it stands to reason that weekend operational hours would help more people who are in crisis. So I'm very happy that this event is being held on a weekend, and that it will be held right here in the village. Hamilton county has a higher infant mortality rate than the national average, and higher than the average for the State of Ohio as well. This is also true for teen mortality rates (kids through the age of 19). The resource event has a number of service providers (beyond the 513 relief bus) that will be here at the park to provide information and hands on services supporting better outcomes for infants and youth in Hamilton County. I've attached a full list of the providers that will be in attendance. As it is a family event, we have some activities for kids while the adults are learning about resources— Cincinnati Circus will be providing a number of games, and Kona Ice will be here with FREE icees while supplies last.

I've attached to my report a list of the service providers that will be in attendance. I've put a notice on the website to help get the word out to any of our local residents who may be in need, please share it widely!
